Johnson & Wales University's Global Summer Programs offers workshops, seminars and laboratory classes in collaboration with organizations and institutions that are partners with JWU. The programs range from cultural programming and direct coursework to industry excursion options and more — anything is possible.

CUSTOMIZABLE AND THEMATIC PROGRAM OPTIONS

JWU is offering the opportunity for deeper educational collaboration with our international communities and partners. Some of these programs will be led by JWU faculty, while various external resources, approved by JWU, may lead other programs.



HIGHLIGHTS AND BENEFITS OF PROGRAMS FOR PARTNERS AND STUDENTS

- Accommodations are in shared dormitory-type rooms, on or near campus.
- The average cost of a two-week program is \$3,200 and includes accommodations, arrival services, most meals, educational modules, and program activities and excursions. Customized program content and fees are available.
- Each JWU campus is located in an easily-accessible city and within proximity to major transportation.
- JWU collaborates with a large number of industry partners in many of the world's top global and influential cities.
- Programs run for one to four weeks during June, July or August and at one or more of JWU's four campuses.
- All programs are collaborations that focus on multidimensional interaction and innovation.
- Students practice creative thinking by exploring possibilities and ideas that are "outside the box."



ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

A nomination letter from the students' home educational institutions ensuring their English language proficiency must accompany student application materials. English language practice is part of our Language & Culture modules.







CULINARY ARTS

Students discover their passion for food while exploring culinary arts in our topnotch laboratories featuring the latest equipment. Taught by renowned JWU chef instructors, these hands-on seminars focus on local ingredients, regional cooking techniques and favorite recipes that make whole foods taste good.



HOSPITALITY

Students participate in academic sessions presented by JWU faculty to support their passion for a career in the global hospitality industry. They meet leaders from international companies to discuss events and trends shaping today's hospitality industry and experience regionally-renowned hospitality through local area excursions.



ENGINEERING & DESIGN

Students have an opportunity to talk to current JWU engineering and design students, faculty experts and visiting industry leaders.
